GENERAL CONDITIONS

E-tenders are invited for the supply of DOLOMITE POWDER at TCL units at Nattakom, Kottayam and Thiruvananthapuram under rate contract basis as per the specification and as per the following conditions.

1. The tenders shall be submitted as e tender through www.etenders.kerala.gov.in. Other mode of submission will not be accepted.
2. The Tender has two parts. Part A and Part B.
 - **Part A :**
 - a) Duly filled Annexure I in PDF format.
 - b) **Sample Dolomite powder (1/2 KG each)** in sealed cover superscribing “ **Sample**” should be forwarded to “**The Deputy Manager (C), Travancore Cements Limited, Nattakom PO, Kottayam, Kerala, 686013**”. Further supplies against the result of this tender should be matching with the approved sample supplied. Submitting sample by existing suppliers of Dolomite powder is not mandatory.
 - **Part B:**

Part B, the Price part (BOQ) of the tender shall be submitted to the e-portal till.
3. **How to deposit EMD:** Bidder desires of taking part in a bid shall log to www.etenders.kerala.gov.in then select tender and initiate e-payment. Payment of EMD through any mode other than e-payment criteria acceptable for Kerala Govt. e-tendering system will not be accepted. **Payments through banks other than State Bank of India (SBI) shall be made 72 hours before the tender submission end time.**
4. **Refund of EMD:** Processing of refunds will be carried out by State Bank in the following stages as per the G.O. (MS) No.11/2013/ITD dated 10.4.2013.
 - a) After opening of Bid (Incomplete bid or withdrawal of bids)
 - b) After technical bid evaluation (Rejected bids)
 - c) After financial bid evaluation (All bids other than L1 & L2)
 - d) EMD of L2 bidder only after award of Contract/execution of agreement with L1.
 - e) Cancellation of tender (all bidders).
 - f) Successful bidder’s EMD may be returned to the contractor by the TCL after the expiry of the contract.

5. Validity of contract lies over a period of 1 year from the date of executing contract. However the Contract is extendable for another period subject to the satisfactory performance of the contract and on mutual consent. TCL also has the liberty to suspend supplies with 15 days notice.
6. Weighment will be done at TCL's Weigh Bridge or Weight Bridge authorized by TCL shall be final and binding on the contractor and shall be witnessed by them or their representative. However, if the Contractor or his representative is not present, TCL reserves the right to weigh the load in their absence.
7. The additional quantity of 20% should be supplied against specific requisition, if made, without any increase in rate.
8. The materials shall be supplied to TCL or any other destination directed by TCL, as per the supply schedule from time to time, based on the requirement of TCL. As per TCL's requirement/production plan, supply schedule for the required quantity will be intimated. **Supply shall be made in part (10MT/16MT/21MT/25MT lot) as per TCL supply schedule and not effecting the supply of entire tendered quantity at a time.**
9. Packing of dolomite powder shall be made in 50KG HDPE/PP bags. Proper covering shall be made to avoid contamination during transit.
10. The final acceptance of the tenders rests entirely with TCL who do not bind themselves to accept the lowest or any tender. But the tenderers on their part should be prepared to carry out such portion of the supplies included in their tenders as may be allotted to them.
11. In case where a successful tenderer, after having made partial supplies fails to fulfill the contracts in full or any of the materials not supplied may at the discretion of the TCL be purchased by means of another tender quotation or by negotiation or from the next higher tenderer who had offered to supply already and the loss if any, caused to the TCL shall together with such sums as may be fixed by the TCL towards damages be recovered from the defaulting tenderer.
12. TCL shall be the liberty to amend/alter/cancel the tender/conditions and/or to extend the due date of tender submission at its discretion.
13. TCL reserves the right to cancel the contract if the contractor fails to comply with the contractual obligations or fails to perform contract to the satisfaction of the TCL. In the event of cancellation of contract as mentioned above, loss sustained to TCL on this account will be levied from the contractor.

14. TCL may have its discretion to increase /decrease the quantity of item and the same will be bound to the tenderer. TCL also have right to cancel the tender at any stage without assigning any reason thereof.
15. **Payment: Payment for material cost will be made within 15 days of receipt of bills submitted by the supplier for the accepted quantity of material. Freight charges if any on to pay basis will consider if required.**
16. Separate bills should be submitted for material cost and transporting charges. T.D.S as per rules will be deducted from bills.
17. Special conditions, if any, of the tenderers attached with the tender will not be applicable to the contract unless they are expressly accepted in writing by the TCL.
18. Consignment(s) either in part or in full not conforming to specification will be rejected and the decision of the TCL, shall be final and no dispute will be entertained. If consignment rejected, same will be intimated to party in writing and materials should be cleared from the TCL at contractor's/tenderer's own cost and risk. On failure, claim of the same will not be accepted.
19. TCL have the right to test the material at loading and/or despatch point at random basis. The certificate of analysis determined by the TCL as per tendered specification shall be final and binding on both parties.
20. TCL reserves the right:
 - i. To accept at its sole and unfettered discretion any tender whole or part quantities or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever at any stage of tender.
 - ii. To place orders on one or more number of firms.
 - iii. To enter into parallel contracts simultaneously or at any time during the period of contract with one or more bidder(s) as TCL may think fit.
 - iv. If the contractor cannot supplies the ordered quantity, TCL reserves the right to buy from other parties also to match with L1 rate or at negotiated price.
 - v. To award the work at 70:30 ratio with L1 and with L2 at the rate of L1 and in case of default/non supply of L1 party, the balance tendered quantity can be purchased from L2 party at L1 rate.
21. TCL does not have any responsibility on the consignments during transportation to TCL.
22. TCL will not be responsible for any accident for men and machinery while loading/unloading/ transporting the material.

23. **Court of Jurisdiction:** The Legal jurisdiction of the contract shall be the competent court at Kottayam, Kerala only.

24. TCL will not be held responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced by the bidders during the submission of bids/payment by online.

25. In the above clauses, TCL means Travancore Cements Limited.
