INVITING QUOTATIONS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF FURNACE OIL SLUDGE

We invite competitive quotations from interested parties having enough facility and petroleum products handling license for the disposal of furnace oil sludge available in furnace oil tank (25000 Kilo Gram) at our factory premises at Nattakom, Kottayam. Projected quantity may vary at actuals. Those interested may submit their bids at TCL **on or before 24.3.2025 @ 2 PM.**

A. How to apply:

1. Bids shall be submitted in a single cover addressing to Chief Manager(O)IC, The Travancore Cements Ltd, Nattakom, PO, Kottayam - 686013 on or before the last date superscribing "Quotation for the removal of furnace oil sludge". Bid shall contain Rate per KG including GST, Communication address, e-Mail ID and contact Numbers, Tentative date of start of work and work completion time.
 - a) Bid must include duly signed and sealed offer in letter head.
 - b) Petroleum products handling license.
 - c) Other registration details like GST, PAN.
 - d) A brief write-up about the bidder and their work plan.

B. Commercial Terms and Conditions:

1. Before bidding, prospective bidders are advised to visit the site for knowing the ground conditions.
2. Rate shall be offered on per KG basis of Furnace oil sludge. Rate quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, labour charges, transportation cost etc.
3. Work includes desludging, transferring sludge from TCL tank to truck and transportation from TCL to bidders specified location.
4. Bidder has to arrange truck, pump for loading material from tank to truck, tools and tackles and all other consumables and safety gadgets required for the work at their own cost and risk.
5. Loading/unloading works and transportation of the sludge to their end are to the account of bidder.
6. The contractor shall ensure the work completion in the shortest possible time.
7. Electricity required for the work will be provided by the company free of cost. Service of JCB/Mobile crane will be extended on request and its availability subject to payment fixed.
8. Under no circumstances loaded material should be off loaded without company's consent.
9. It is the responsibility of the bidder to arrange movement pass and other relevant permissions for carrying the furnace oil sludge from concerned authorities.
10. It is responsibility of the bidder to arrange experts/safety professional for executing the work.
11. TCL does not have any responsibility and liability on vehicles leaving to and from its premises.
12. Spillages of oil shall be avoided and it is the responsibility of bidder to clear the same if happened.
13. Work should be completed within 15 days from date of award of contract.
14. **Payments:** Successful bidder will have to remit 25% of the total value as advance deposit within 5 days of receipt of the sale order. TCL will issue invoices based on the weighment inside the

weighbridge of TCL. Bidder has to make payments against each invoices issued as per weighment certificate. Vehicles will be permitted to move out only after remittance of payments issued against each invoices to TCL account. The advance amount remitted by the bidder will be adjusted against last invoice value.

C. General terms and conditions

1. By submitting offer, it is presumed that the bidder accepted all of the terms and conditions of the contract.
2. Offer should be clear and unambiguous. All the rates quoted should be both in figures and words. Language of bid shall be English. Rate quoted shall be valid for 90 days from bid submission date.
3. The rate quoted shall have to remain firm during the pendency of contract.
4. Highest quoted bid will be considered for award of contract in normal cases.
5. TDS/TCS applicable will be applicable to the contract as per rules.
6. Bidder has to give name and other details of employees deployed for the work at security dept of TCL.
7. TCL reserves the right to accept and or reject any or all the quotation without assigning any reason whatsoever.
8. TCL does not bind itself to accept the highest tender or assign any reason for non- acceptance of the same.
9. TCL reserves the right to modify the terms at its discretion.
10. Bidder is solely responsible for their personnel inside TCL. TCL will not be responsible for any accident and damage for men and machinery while doing the work/transporting the material.
11. Bidder shall observe all the HSE rules/regulations/orders of Central & State Government and local authorities in doing the work. If any breach of the said rules/orders, the bidder shall be solely responsible for this.
12. Since the contract of TCL with the bidder only, TCL is no way connected to any third party in this contract.
13. TCL is empowered to forfeit the SD at its discretion, in case the bidder fails to obey the contractual obligations. TCL reserves the right to cancel the contract, if the bidder fails to comply with the contractual obligations or fails to perform contract to the satisfaction of the company. In the event of cancellation of contract as mentioned above, loss sustained to TCL on this account will be levied from the bidder.
14. The bidder shall be liable for any omission, neglect or misconduct on his own part or on the part of his servants/employees/agents/representatives.
15. Special terms and conditions if any attached with the bid shall not be applicable to the contract unless same is accepted by TCL in writing.
16. COURT OF JURISDICTION: The legal jurisdiction of the contract shall be the competent court at Kottayam, Kerala only.
17. In the above clauses, TCL means Travancore Cements Limited.
